

OBSERVER RULES AND REGULATIONS Silesian Guitar Autumn 2026

§1

General Provisions

The following Rules and Regulations apply to Observers in the "Silesian Guitar Autumn 2026", organised by the Municipal Culture Centre in Tychy and held in the city of Tychy from 17 to 24 October 2026. (hereinafter referred to as the "Event").

The terms used in these Rules and Regulations shall mean:

- a. Organiser - Municipal Culture Centre in Tychy
- b. Observer – a natural person who has submitted an application, has been qualified by the Organiser, and is entitled to the benefits provided for the Observer, including in particular participation in Festival events and (where applicable) accommodation and meals.
- c. OBSERVER FORM - registration form for "Silesian Guitar Autumn 2026 - OBSERVER FORM"
- d. Concert Pass – a pass entitling the holder to attend the Festival concerts; the purchase of the pass is an integral part of Observer status.

§2

Rules for Application and Obtaining Observer Status

1. Observer Status is granted on the basis of a correctly completed and submitted Observer Form available on the website guitar.tychy.pl, no later than 18 September 2026.
2. Submission of the Observer Form only constitutes an expression of intent to participate in the Event and does not constitute the granting of Observer status.
3. Qualified persons will be notified by e-mail no later than 4 October 2026.
4. Admission shall be determined by the order of applications.
5. The conditions for obtaining Observer status include, in particular:
 - a. submission of an application through the registration form available on the website guitar.tychy.pl, no later than 18 September 2026,
 - b. participation in competition auditions, concerts included in the pass, and the academic-artistic session,
 - c. payment of fees arising from the selected services (accommodation/meals/pass) within the deadline specified by the Organiser, in accordance with price list §3 item (2).

§3

Fees and Services for Observers

1. The Observer may receive the following services:
 - a. accommodation at Hotel Arena (single, double or triple room) with a discount for festival participants,
 - b. meal services at Hotel Arena with a festival participant discount,
 - c. Concert Pass, as selected in the registration form,
 - d. In addition, the Observer shall receive:
 - festival package,
 - Certificate of participation in the festival.
2. Price list:
 - Single room with breakfast - PLN 300 (per night),
 - Bed in a double room with breakfast - PLN 200 (per night),
 - Bed in a triple room with breakfast - PLN 150 (per night)
 - Meals: lunch + dinner – PLN 140 (two-course lunch with dessert and a drink, and a hot dinner with a drink, per day).
 - Concert pass: FULL OBSERVER PASS (PLN 450, includes all concerts at Mediateka from 17 to 24 October) or BASIC OBSERVER PASS (PLN 360, includes concerts at Mediateka from 20 to 24 October)
3. Payment methods:
 - a. accommodation and meals – payable in cash or by card at the hotel reception.
 - b. Concert Pass – payment at the Organiser’s office or by bank transfer to the Organiser’s bank account: **44 1240 1330 1111 0010 7505 0767**, with payment reference: “name and surname, Observer SJG”.
4. In order to obtain an invoice, the Observer must provide invoice details in the registration form.

§4

Rules for Accommodation and Stay arrangements

1. The Observer provides the following details in the Observer form:
 - a. date and time of arrival and departure,
 - b. preferred room type (single/double/triple),
 - c. In the case of a double or triple room – option to indicate another Observer to share the accommodation.
2. The Observer undertakes to comply with the order and organisational rules in force at the accommodation venue and at Festival venues, in particular health and safety and fire protection regulations.
3. The Observer who causes damage to the room or the premises shall be fully responsible for such damage.
4. The Observer is obliged to immediately inform the Organiser of any changes to contact details and any circumstances that may affect the stay (e.g. changes to arrival/departure dates and times).

§5

Observer's Obligations

1. The Observer is obligated to:
 - a. participate in Festival events in a manner that does not interfere with their course,
 - b. take due care of the property provided as part of the accommodation and Festival infrastructure,
 - c. comply with the applicable legal regulations, including safety rules.
2. The Observer acknowledges that Observer status and access to the services (including the promotional package and certificate) are granted to the person whose application has been qualified by the Organiser.

§6

Cancellation and Changes

1. In the event of cancellation of hotel services by the Observer within 7 days prior to the start of the Festival, the Hotel shall charge the Observer the full amount for the hotel services, except in unforeseen circumstances, such as illness confirmed by a doctor or other unforeseen event preventing participation in the Festival.
2. In the event of organisational changes beyond the Organiser's control (e.g. due to unavailability of the venue), the Organiser may propose alternative solutions of a similar standard.

§7

Personal Data Processing (GDPR)

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Municipal Culture Centre in Tychy (hereinafter: MCK),
with its registered office at 43-100 Tychy, ul. Bohaterów Warszawy 26
2. Contact with the Administrator regarding the Observer's participation in the Festival is possible as follows:

3. Contact with the Data Protection Officer is possible as follows:

4. Your personal data is processed for the purpose of organising the Observer's stay at the Festival, and issuing certificates confirming Observer participation in the Festival. In addition, they will be disclosed to entities with which the Municipal Culture Centre has entered into a contract:
 - a) for the provision of financial and accounting services for the purpose of issuing invoices,
 - b) or the provision of IT system maintenance services (including the website

www.guitar.tychy.pl) used for their processing.

5. Processing is necessary for the performance of a task undertaken by the Municipal Culture Centre (MCK) in the public interest, namely the organisation of cultural events, on the basis of Article 6 (1) (e) of the GDPR, and the provisions of the Act of 25 October 1991, on Organising and Conducting Cultural Activity.
6. Your personal data may be disclosed only to entities authorised under applicable law to receive them, as well as to entities providing IT system maintenance services to the Administrator pursuant to concluded agreements.
7. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purpose of processing, and, where required under the provisions on the national archival resource and archives, for 25 years.
8. Under the GDPR, you have the following rights, in particular:
 - a. the right to access your data and receive a copy thereof;
 - b. the right to rectification of your personal data and the right to erasure, where there is no legal basis for further processing
 - c. the right to restrict the processing of your personal data or to object to its processing,
 - d. the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw).
9. Providing your personal data is necessary to complete the formalities related to the participation of the Observer in the Event.

§8

Final Provisions

1. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Event due to force majeure circumstances, in particular: martial law, natural disaster, fire, flood, adverse weather conditions, national or local mourning, or a major power failure.
2. A breach of the provisions of these Rules and Regulations by the Observer may result in the revocation of Observer status, and being excluded from the possibility of applying for the Observer status in future events held by the Organiser.
3. Submitting the registration form is equivalent to accepting these Rules and Regulations.
4. These Rules and Regulations shall enter into force on the date of publication on the website: www.guitar.tychy.pl
5. The Organiser reserves the right to make changes to these Rules and Regulations provided that Observers are notified in advance on the website: www.guitar.tychy.pl
6. The Organiser is not responsible for losses incurred by Observers due to unforeseen circumstances, including theft, and due to circumstances outside of the Organiser's responsibility.
